Dear Parents and Carers,

In my letter before half term, I said I would be providing parents and carers with further information this week regarding the partial reopening of Christ Church C.E. Primary School. Following a meeting of the full governing body, the decision has been made that the school will not be reopening to pupils in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 before Monday 15th June. Whilst coming to this decision, the ongoing health and safety of all in the Christ Church family was of the highest importance and at the centre of the governing body's discussions.

You will of course have many questions regarding how the school may reopen in the coming weeks and I shall write to you after half term, in order to begin to give you more information regarding this.

Due to essential works, the school site is fully closed to all pupils and staff until Friday 29th May. If you require childcare before Friday 29th May and are a key worker, or the parent of a child deemed 'vulnerable', please email Birmingham City Education Officers on eds.enquiries@birmingham.gov.uk.

On Monday 1st June, Christ Church CE Primary School will remain closed to the majority of pupils. From the 1st June, if you are a key worker, or the parent of a child deemed 'vulnerable' and require childcare (in line with government guidance), please contact enquiry@christch.com or call the school telephone number. Please give at least 24 hours notice.

I look forward to writing to you next week to let you know more about our plans for reopening. In the meantime, if you have any questions please do not hesitate to email us and ask.
