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Home school agreement to take account of Covid 19 safety arrangements

We will ensure the following safety measures are in place and adhered to at all times to ensure all children accessing school remain safe. For this to happen, we have introduced these measures in an updated Home-School agreement that must be adhered to if you and your child are going to accessing our school as we must have 100% commitment to these safety measures.

Parents and children must:

Start and end of school day (These will be staggered times for different years groups see separate letter)

- Only use the specified areas of school that parents are allowed to use and use the agreed entrance and exits (these will be communicated as each year group returns to school and will be signposted clearly)
- Adhere to social distancing when waiting to drop off or collect children (using markers that indicate social distancing)
- Contact the school office via telephone or email only as our school office will remain closed to parents during this time. There will be no access to the school office following drop-off.
- Leave the premises immediately once children are either dropped off or collected
- Adhere to the strict start and end times (entrance to the school site will be locked at the specified start time and will not be opened for late comers)
- Only one parent can drop and collect a child
- Arrive punctually at the time allocated for their year group and collect them promptly.
- If a child is distressed because of social distancing we will request you take them home.
- Where possible to reduce the risk of infection a daily change of clothes.
- Parents to provide on a daily basis a named water bottle and an individual packet of tissues.

Within the school day:

Staff and children must wash their hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds across the school day, particularly:

- After coming in to school
- After sneezing and coughing
- Before and after handling or eating food
- After going to the toilet

Children must adhere, where possible, to social distancing measures throughout all areas of school including:

- The classroom
- Corridors
- The playground
- Toilets
- Dining hall

Children must only use the equipment allocated to them (this equipment will be cleaned before the next session)

Government advice states that wearing a face covering or face mask in schools or other educational settings is not recommended.

We request that wherever possible, children have a new change of clothes each day.

Lunch/ Snacks:

- The school kitchen will provide packed lunches for those who normally have school meals. Those who have free school meals will not pay for these packed lunches.
- You will need to provide your child with a daily water bottle as water fountains cannot be used on the school site.

If your child/ children presents with symptoms:

- In school if your child presents with symptoms you will be contacted immediately. Children will wait in a designated area in isolation, until they can be collected. You and the rest of the family must then self-isolate in line with government guidance before returning to school.
- If any member of the household presents with symptoms in line with government guidance, your child must NOT come to school or any other family member and needs to self-isolate as required at home. School need to be notified on the first day of self-isolation. The child must be tested and school informed of the results via telephone as soon as possible.

- If a child or member of staff tests positive for Covid19, school will follow guidelines from the government around closure of a group/ year group or school according to contact child has had with others.

Social distancing outside of school:

- If your child begins to return to school it is important that out of school that all members of your household is adhering to current government guidelines.
- On the 4th July travel advice changed, with exemptions for travelling to certain countries that no longer pose a high risk for British travellers. Please follow the Foreign and Commonwealth office advice and if you need to self-isolate please be ready for your child to start school on Thursday 3rd September.
- **By your child attending, both you and your child are agreeing to follow the above. If you do not adhere to this agreement, your child cannot safely return to school and therefore will not be able to attend until the above agreement is agreed to and is being adhered to.**
